## Standing Rules of the Malta Tennis Federation applicable to the Game of Padel

The MALTA TENNIS FEDERATION (FEDERAZZJONI MALTIJA TENNIS), hereinafter referred to as the MTF, is hereby adopting the following standing rules that regulate the ordinary administration of the MTF for the PADEL GAME.

- 1. The Game of Padel Open Tournament Season will start annually 1<sup>st</sup> January through to 31 December of each year.
- 2. All open tournaments sanctioned by the Malta Tennis Federation (MTF) will be played in accordance with the official International Padel Federation's (IPF) regulations. Refer to REGULATIONS OF THE PADEL GAME annexed to our website.
- 3. The MTF have determined, in accordance to IPF Regulations, that all encounters will be played on a 3 Set basis. In the event of a 6 game all proceeding for the set, the set will be decided based on a 1,2,3,4... point tie break up to 7 points. This always with a 2-point advantage, for which the tie break will proceed up and until that 2-point advantage is reached. In the event that the first two sets are shared between the opposing pairs, a third set deciding the encounter will be played on a Super Tie Break in which case this will be played up to one pair who reach 10 points with a 2 point advantage. Again here, the two points advantage rule will apply and as such the 3<sup>rd</sup> set will be played up and until that 2 point advantage is reached.
- 4. The MTF hereby directs organising clubs for their organisation of sanctioned Open Tournaments that:
- Ranking points assigned per athlete of the pair to the participating athletes will be as follows:
